Led by volunteers working to improve our certification process by continual review of the examination and associated study materials, and further our outreach and engagement with CHIDs.




Commitment to Credentialing Excellence

Become an Emeritus CHID

If you retire from your healthcare interior design career, or transition to another field, you can apply for “Emeritus CHID” status.

If approved, you will be granted the right to use the Emeritus CHID appellation.

To apply, email AAHID at info@aahid.org. A one-time administrative fee is required. The AAHID board will consider your application at their next quarterly board meeting. Individuals accepted as Emeritus CHID will receive official notification of new status.

Note: To be considered for Emeritus CHID status, you must be a CHID in good standing. If your CHID certification has lapsed, prior to which you were a CHID in good standing, AAHID will consider providing an exception.

Portfolio Review: Credentialing Committee (CHID Exam Application Review Committee)

Annually, this group of CHIDs carefully reviews potential exam candidate applications to ensure that applicants have met the exam requirements and have the training, education and experience to qualify to take the exam to become CHID Certified Healthcare Interior Designer® professionals.

AAHID White Paper on Flooring Selection Committee (Research & Education Committee)

The White Paper Committee worked over the course of two years to develop a white paper on the benefits of resilient flooring. Sponsored by Tarkett, this team worked in conjunction with Tarkett to develop the paper. The committee reviewed FGI guidelines and conducted a literary review, interviewed industry experts, and referenced case studies to compile the data for the white paper, which covers flooring selection, the design process, healthcare associated infections, patient safety, sheet vs. tile goods, and reducing post-installation setbacks. There are more opportunities for further research. The white paper was completed at the end of 2021 and officially published in January of 2022. In October of 2022, the paper will be presented as one of AAHID's education sessions at HCD in San Antonio, TX. Special thanks goes out to Isabella Sirkis of CRGA Design for her contributions!

Study Prep Committee

2021 was a busy inaugural year for the AAHID Study Prep Committee. In early 2021, several roundtable discussions to share study prep experiences and brainstorm possible initiatives to improve study prep tools and better support prospective CHIDs, resulted in the implementation of several new initiatives, including: A CHID Community Connections virtual event, for prospective exam candidates to review the exam process and benefits of becoming a CHID. A survey of exam candidates about study reference materials revealed an interest in AAHID offering materials at a reduced rate. Unfortunately, AAHID was unable to arrange a reduction of cost to access FGI, the primary and most costly reference for the exam. In July, a CHID Community Connections virtual event for 47 attendees, focused on preparing for the upcoming exam, review of the exam process, and study prep tips. AAHID provided candidates with the means and contacts to form study groups using social media. The November CHID Community Connections event congratulated our newest CHIDs of 2021. Test Development Committee (TDC)

The TDC is responsible for the preparation, administration, validation, and ongoing exam development of the CHID certification examination. The TDC consists of the chair appointed by the board, one director, and six (6) to nine (9) individuals who are not members of the Board and who hold the CHID appellation. The CHIDs are the Subject Matter Experts (SME), who periodically review and revise the current CHID exam, according to current best practices, along with the Exam Content Objectives, Jobs Task Analysis, Exam References, and Candidate Handbook.

On an annual basis, TDC analyzes survey results and feedback from the previous year's examinees. Every February and March, TDC uses this information and works closely with the test delivery vendor to revise and create new beta test items to maintain the integrity of the CHID examination.

The committee welcomed two new members from the 2020 CHID cycle: Sarah Harvey and Cindy Lescale. Thank you to the dedicated efforts of all the committee members who contribute to making the examination the essential certification for healthcare interior designers.

DCF - Durable Coated Fabrics Task Group

In 2017, the AAHID board of directors and several CHIDs attended Design Connections in Ponte Vedra, FL. This unique gathering brought together designers, manufacturers, associations, and trade partners for frank conversations about performance failures in healthcare. After the conference, a group continued to meet regularly with the goal of finding solutions to this challenge. We have gathered data, conducted surveys, provided education sessions, and promoted field tests and research. Under the auspices of AAHID and with the help of CFFA (Chemical Fabrics and Film Association) DCF has presented the CFFA-Healthcare-201-Standard certification for minimum performance testing required to reduce durable coated fabric failures in the healthcare environment.

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
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
