

# Certification Check List

## CHID Eligibility Criteria

**Pathway 1:** A minimum of three (3) years experience in healthcare interior design or healthcare architecture and NCIDQ or NCARB certification.

**Pathway 2:** A minimum of ten (10) years of experience in healthcare interior design or healthcare architecture, no certification required.

\*Candidates who do not take the exam in September or would like to re-take the examination may pay a \$200 fee to sit from November 1-30.

The CHID exam is 165 questions and 3 hours in length. 30 of the 165 questions are pre-test items that are not scored.

### DAY OF EXAM WITH LIVE REMOTE PROCTORING (LRP)

- Review the Technical Requirements and Exam Day Instructions in the CHID Candidate Handbook.
- Ensure your exam-taking environment is quiet (no visitors/children) and clear of any books/materials throughout the entire duration of the 3-hour exam.
- Have one form of identification that contains a current photograph, your current name, and your signature to show your proctor prior to starting the exam. Examples of acceptable identification include:
  - Driver's license with photograph
  - State identification card with photograph
  - Passport
  - Military identification card with photograph

*No forms of temporary identification will be accepted.*
- You will receive your score immediately upon completion of your LRP exam.
